There are more than 700,000 law enforcement professionals in the United States. It is logistically impossible to accommodate all of them with a program in Israel. In order to address the growing interest in LEEP, JINSA has been organizing conferences in the United States specifically planned to encapsulate the lessons of the program in Israel.

Since 2004, 12 regional LEEP conferences have been held in the United States, with a total attendance of over 9,500 law enforcement officials.

The two-day conferences are done in cooperation with the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP), the Major County Sheriffs' Association and the Police Executive Research Forum (PERF), and have been co-sponsored by major state security agencies, state Homeland Security offices and/or law enforcement departments.

Topics addressed during LEEP conferences include: Suicide Bombings: Methodology and Responses; Managing the Coordinated Response to Acts of Terrorism; Identifying and Understanding the Global Enemy; Secure Borders; The Homegrown Threat; Mindset of the Suicide Bomber; The Intelligence Process: Overview, Intel Sharing and Source Development; The Relationship Between Public Law Enforcement and Private Security; The 21st Century Policeman – Skills and Training; and New Security Technologies.
