**Assistant Director Doron Tenne** is currently the Israel Security Agency, ISA (Shabak) Attaché at the Embassy of Israel in Washington, DC as the key liaison to the FBI. Previously, Director Tenne served as the head of an Operational Division and the senior member of the ISA Board (2004-2009). From 1999-2004, Tenne was the Section Chief in the ISA for Intelligence Collection.

The ISA, officially known by the acronym Shabak and commonly known as the Shin Bet is Israel's internal security service. Its motto is "Defender that shall not be seen" or "The unseen shield." It is one of three principal organizations of the Israeli intelligence community, alongside Aman (the military intelligence of the IDF) and Mossad.

Director Tenne has previously served in various capacities in the Israeli Defense Forces. From 1996-1999, as Lieutenant Colonel, Tenne was Operational Unit Commander. From 1990-1995, he was Unit Chief of Intelligence and from 1987-1988, Director Tenne served as Bureau Manager and Top Military Assistant to the Commander of the IDF's Military Intelligence. Tenne was awarded the 'Israeli Security Award' which is the highest award granted within the Israeli security and intelligence community.

JINSA has been privileged to work with Doron Tenne through its Law Enforcement Exchange Program (LEEP). Tenne brings an experienced perspective to the challenges facing the U.S., Israel and other countries fighting the scourge of worldwide terrorism and extremism.
